It is with great pleasure and excitement that we write to share **Dr. Carina Yang** has been named the inaugural **Faculty Director of Fellowship Accreditation in the Graduate Medical Education (GME) Office!**



Dr. Carina Yang is an Associate Professor of Radiology, Vice Chair of Diversity & Inclusion, and the Director of Pediatric Neuroradiology. She also served as the Director of the Neuroradiology Fellowship for 8 years.

A triple major at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Dr. Yang completed her medical degree at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, and stayed local to complete her Radiology Residency as well as Neuroradiology Fellowship at Northwestern. She previously worked in Pediatric Neuroradiology at Lurie Children's Hospital in Chicago. She joined University of Chicago in 2013.

Dr. Yang is highly devoted to educating students, trainees, and radiologists from around the world. She was the recipient of the University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine Medical Education Research, Innovation, Teaching and Scholarship (MERITS) in 2016-2017. She was selected as a 2022-2023 Senior Faculty Scholar in the Bucksbaum Institute for Clinical Excellence, and was selected to participate in the Society of Chairs of Academic Radiology Departments (SCARD)-GE Leading Empowering and Disrupting (LEAD) Program for 2022. She was elected by her peers as a member of the University of Chicago Division of the Biological Sciences Faculty Advisory Committee to the Deans. Dr. Yang also served on the search committee for the Associate Dean for GME last year.

Dr. Yang is a leader in the field of medical simulation in radiology. An expert in the use of simulation to train residents and fellows, she has authored several peer-reviewed articles on the use of simulation in radiology. She has completed multiple international visiting professorships imparting pediatric neuroradiology knowledge across the world, including the 2019 Anne G. Osborn American Society of North America International Outreach Professor.

Dr. Yang begins her position as GME Faculty Director of Fellowship Accreditation on April 1, 2023 and reports directly to Dr. Chrissy Babcock, our Associate Dean for GME/DIO, and will work closely with the other GME Directors and staff to advance the fellowship training programs. With her prior tenure as a fellowship program director and her skills in education and scholarship, we look forward to her support on fellowship annual updates, leading special program reviews and overseeing the new non-standard training fellowships. With Dr. Yang in this new role, we are positioned to further increase engagement between our fellowships and GME. Please join us in congratulating Dr. Yang on this new role!
